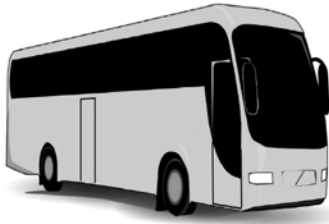

have two (2) garage or yard sales per year. Each sale may not consist of more than two (2) consecutive days. A Berkeley Township permit is required to be obtained for each yard sale conducted.

HANDICAP RESERVED SPACES

No parking in Handicap reserved spaces without a visible license plate and ID Tag. Finable by Berkeley Township Police Department.

PARKING - Commercial vehicles are not permitted in your driveway. Parking on your lawn is also not permitted.

SPEEDING IN OUR COMMUNITY

The speed limit is **25 MPH** in residential areas. Those of you who have children living with you and who have the privilege of living here in our 55+ community

are racing through our streets. Please tell them to **SLOW DOWN** and to **STOP AT STOP SIGNS**. Every day there are near misses in our community. It's not worth your life or someone else's life. **PLEASE SLOW DOWN!!**

CURBING YOUR PET- All pets must be confined within the Owner's Lot/Living Unit except when being walked on a hand-held leash, not to exceed six feet (6') in length. Pet Owners are permitted to use the easement/patch of grass between the sidewalk and the curb. **All Pet Owners must collect their pet's feces.** Failure to pick up after your pet is a Holiday Heights fineable offense for each occurrence. There will also be an additional fine for each infraction under the Berkeley Township Ordinance (05-25-OAB-3). We expect all Pet Owners to be respectful of other Owners and in return, we expect Owners to show the same respect for Pet Owners.

THE CODE COMMITTEE

Holiday Heights was thoughtfully developed in the early 1990's as a stable, attractive and well-regulated 55+ community. Rules and regulations were considered by the residents to maintain a community with high standards to keep home values higher and thus maintain a more desirable community for future homeowners.

The Code Committee "shall have the authority to initiate a complaint, reported or observed, and investigate violations and/or complaints arising from and relating to the Declaration, Bylaws, and Rules." As stated in the original articles of incorporation, #4 Purposes and Powers (G.) "to enforce the provisions of the Declaration, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations and the Certificate of Incorporation of the Association ..."

The Code Committee plays a vital role in protecting the integrity, appearance, and property values of our community. The Code Committee will initiate complaints as needed.

The Code Committee meets Monday mornings from 9:30AM -11:00AM in the Multi-Purpose Meeting Room (MPMR) in the Office Building (Building #1) and are available to answer questions & provide guidance necessary for all exterior project requests. You can also call 732-244-8686 Ext.#220 and leave a message.

An Exterior Project Application Form, including all specifications necessary for the proposed project, as well as a Holiday Heights Project Permit are required before any work can begin. Please note: A Berkeley Township permit will be required when applicable. A copy of the Berkeley Township permit, as well as the Holiday Heights Project Permit, are required to be posted prior to the start of any work. The Code Committee continues to process applications for exterior projects as quickly as possible. The expected time for review and approval is approximately two (2) weeks. We ask for your patience and your consideration of this timeline when planning all projects.

GRASS CUTTING POLICY

Sprinkler heads are the Owner's responsibility

All Grass Cutting Issues must be reported to the HOA Office in writing, using the Lawn Complaint Form (forms are available at the HOA Office or on our website at (holidayheights.org)). Please do not call the Lawn Contractor or a Director. A complaint form must be filled out for all complaints. If no complaint form is filled out the complaint will be voided.

Damage to property such as siding, fences, borders and sprinklers will be addressed in a timely manner. Our contractor has staff to handle these repairs. Should you have damage, please take responsible measures to prevent further damage. All complaints will be inspected by a Director to determine the cause and action to be taken. Repairs made by homeowners prior to the Director's inspection and without authorization by the Board, will not be reimbursed. Please ensure the cutters have a clear path and your sprinkler heads are down on grass cutting days. Sprinkler heads damaged due to heads being raised during the cut cycle **will not** be repaired by the Lawn Contractor. If you have heads that do not retract, place red do-not cut flags around the head until you can have it repaired, also confirm all ground panels are secured.

Damage to lawns such as scalping and ruts will be considered on a **case-by-case** basis. Some will grow back without intervention. The majority of ruts are caused by the ground being over saturated due to recent rain and/or over watering by the sprinklers. The driver is most likely unaware of the saturated ground until it is too late. Ruts caused by Homeowners over watering their lawn will not be repaired by the Lawn Contractor. Please check your side and rear yards as needed to ensure the ground is not over saturated. If you find there are areas that are over saturated, please obtain red flags from the HOA Office and circle the saturated areas so the mowers know not to cut that area.

No Cut Signs are a violation and are subject to a fine if placed on your lawn.

"No Cut" flags are available in the HOA Office for those not wanting the Association to cut their grass. You will need to fill out the No Lawn Cut form and you will be given flags at the HOA Office. If you change your mind and decide you want your lawn cut, please remove the flags.

Under normal soil conditions, grass requires only ½ to 1 inch of water per week. Our soils are generally wetter due to the high-water table and type of soil; therefore, discuss this with your sprinkler contractor and ask them to adjust the frequency and run times on your sprinkler system for roughly ¾ inch per week. Also ask them to adjust your system as needed throughout the watering season. Remember the water requirements for the area between the homes may be less than the front and back, work with your neighbors to establish a watering schedule. Watering your lawn every day is not needed unless it is a new seeding.

Holiday Heights 2026 Pool Rules

(Our Pool Rules Supersede State Rules)

- Everyone must use personal access cards to enter the pool area including guests. No sign in is required.
- All guests must be accompanied by a Homeowner/Resident and remain with the guest while in the pool area.
- No “solo/alone” swimming. Two people must always be in or at the pool.
- Children may attend the pool between 10:00am to 12:30pm and leave the pool area by 1:00pm. A Homeowner/Resident must be present and supervise children. No children under the age of 3 are allowed in the pool.
- **No children or adult diapers including “Swim diapers, Swimmates, Swimmers, pull ups” are allowed in the pool.**
- Smoking or eating inside the pool area is not allowed.
- No alcohol or recreational drugs are allowed in the pool, pool area, or pavilion. Only plastic bottles are allowed in the pool area.
- The pool and pool area must be cleared for inclement weather and emergency situations. After 30 minutes without any thunder or lightning, you may return to the pool area.
- No shoes, flip flops, towels, goggles, or floatation devices are to be left by the steps or ladders due to safety hazard.
- Chairs, lounges, and tables may **NOT** be reserved. Tables cannot be utilized by anyone or group for all day or evening. The tables are for snacking only. Please keep the tables clean for others during the day and evening.
- All equipment, chairs, lounges, tables, noodles, etc. must be returned to their original place.
- All personal items left at the pool will be discarded at the end of the season.
- No sitting or eating on the pool steps.
- No running, jumping or diving into the pool. No pushing, shoving, rude, loud or profane language will be tolerated. If you are disruptive or refuse to follow the pool rules, you will be requested to refrain from this behavior. Refusal to refrain from this behavior will result in a Director being contacted and you be removed from the pool area. Refusal to be removed may result in a Code of Conduct violation.
- All complaints must go to a Director for a resolution or implementation.
- **If you have an open sore, infection, or diarrhea, please STAY OUT OF THE POOL.**
- Sunscreen should be applied 30 minutes before entering the pool to avoid clogging the pool drains.
- **This is a Senior Community, and we would like to keep it peaceful. Respect others.**
- **The pool will open on Memorial Day weekend and close on September 7th (extension-TBD) weather permitting. Pool Hours are 8am to 8pm unless otherwise posted.**

What is an Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR)?

The N.J. Condominium Act requires that community associations "provide a fair and efficient procedure for the resolution of disputes between individual unit owners and the association, and between unit owners, which shall be readily available as an alternative to litigation." In short, it is mandatory for every homeowner association within the State of N.J. to provide and maintain an effective ADR program.

How do I Request an ADR?

- An ADR Complainant Mediation Packet can be obtained at the HOA Office.
- The Complainant should complete the packet and forwarded by email to the Coalition ADR Coordinator, hereafter known as Coordinator. If you cannot do email, place your documents in a sealed envelope. Write your name across the sealed flap and deliver it to your HOA office and have them contact the Coordinator for pick up
- To preserve the integrity and privacy of your request for an ADR, DO NOT send any supporting documentation at this time.
- Your assigned mediator will be in touch with you.

Petitions opposing A3346 and S791

A-3466: Sponsored by Assemblywoman Lopez (19th District)

- Requires associations of age-restricted common interest communities to permit dwelling owners to transfer property without regard to age of buyer.
- At least one occupant of the dwelling must be at least 55 years of age to comply with the Housing of Older Persons Act (HOPA).

S791: Sponsored by Robert Singer (30th District)

- Prohibits common interest communities from penalizing member who place unit into living, revocable trust fund or classifying placement as title transfer.

Forgotten History .. The Origin of the Insult

Excerpts from "History Nation"

The word "insult" itself comes from the Latin *insultare*, meaning "to leap upon, jump at, or assail". The word first appeared in English in the mid-16th century, initially referring to arrogant gloating after a victory or physical assault. By the 1610s, however, it had evolved to mean verbal abuse or mockery. Insults are likely as old as human communication itself and have long functioned as tools for establishing dominance, social status, or defusing conflict without resorting to physical violence.

As said by Sigmund Freud, "The first human who hurled an insult instead of a stone was the founder of civilization. The oldest written customer complaint, written on two sides of a tablet in Akkadian cuneiform over 3,700 years ago, describes how the copper merchant Ea-nasir told the customer's messenger to "go away" if he was not happy with the quality of

the copper. In around 1200, literary sources began to contain signs of a practice known as flyting. It is sometimes described as verbal jousting or poetic exchanges designed to demonstrate wit.

English has a great literary history of insults. Terms that have fallen out of modern use: *Gongoozler* – person who idly stares at things, *Smell-feast* – some one who only shows up to eat, *Sorner* – a moocher who lives off others, *Tatterdemallion* – person in ragged clothing, *Lubberwort* – a stupid/lethargic person are just a few examples. Shakespeare became one of the most prolific inventor of insults often used for comedic effect or to add tension in his plays. Even the mildest insult can reveal how language records the value, divisions, and assumptions of the societies that shape it.

Shrimp and Veggie Foil Pack

Ingredients:

- 1 lb. large shrimp, peeled and deveined
- 1 c. zucchini, chopped
- 1 c. yellow squash, chopped
- ½ red onion, chopped
- 1 green pepper, chopped
- 1 10-oz package cherry tomatoes
- 1 8-oz. can sweet corn
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 tbsp. minced cilantro or parsley
- 3 tbsp. olive oil
- 1 tsp. paprika
- Salt and pepper to taste.

Directions:

1. Preheat the grill to medium-high heat.
2. In a large bowl, combine all ingredients and toss to mix.
3. Lay out four 18x12-inch sheets of heavy-duty foil, using two sheets per packet with the second sheet placed perpendicular to the first. Divide the shrimp and vegetable mixture into a rectangular shape in the center of each foil stack.
4. Fold and roll the edges to completely seal each packet.
5. Grill the packets for 12-14 minutes, flipping half-way through, until the shrimp is cooked through.
6. Carefully open the packets. Squeeze lemon over the top before serving. Enjoy!

HOLIDAY HEIGHTS FIRST AID SQUAD

The Holiday Heights First Aid Squad was formed in 1987 to serve the residents of Holiday Heights. We currently work a 12-hour shift from 7 am until 1900 (7 pm). The days we work are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday.

Each crew consists of an EMT or Certified Assessor, a driver/ lifter and an information specialist. Both of our ambulances are equipped with hydraulic stretchers that lift the patient into the ambulance.

There are 3 requirements to become a squad member: having a valid driver's license, getting CPR certified, and being able to get on and off the ambulance unassisted.

All crew members are certified in CPR and the use of an AED. Classes are provided in the squad

building, and all costs are covered by the squad. Members that want to be certified as an Assessor or EMT may take the required class at no cost. Drivers attend a CIVO or Advance Emergency Drivers class. Additionally, there are other classes offered by the town or County, and attendance is voluntary.

Uniform shirts and jackets are provided by the Squad. You will need black pants and black shoes.

Most Crews work two or three days per month, and we also have one mandatory meeting per month, usually the fourth Wednesday of the month.

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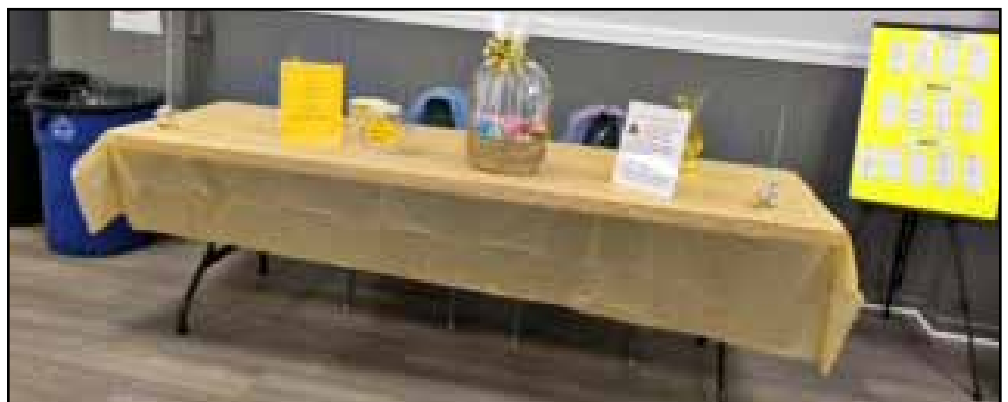
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
