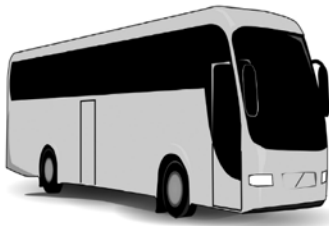

COMPLAINTS

All complaints must be submitted in writing to the Code Committee with your name, address, photo(s) supporting claim and your signature. Forms are available from the Holiday Heights website or from the Association Office. All written complaints will remain anonymous.

NO DUMPING IN THE BASINS!

DUMPSTERS / PODS – Contact the Code Committee before planning to have a dumpster or storage pod placed in your driveway. Call Ext.#220 for details.

GARAGE/ESTATE SALE PERMITS

As per the Berkeley Township Municipal Code: Chapter 5-7.4: "The assessed owner of a property may have two (2) garage or yard sales per year. Each sale may not consist of more than two (2) consecutive days. A Berkeley Township permit is required to be obtained for each yard sale conducted.

HANDICAP RESERVED SPACES

No parking in Handicap reserved spaces without a visible license plate and ID Tag. Finable by Berkeley Township Police Department.

PARKING - Commercial vehicles are not permitted in your driveway. Parking on your lawn is also not permitted.

SPEEDING IN OUR COMMUNITY

The speed limit is 25 MPH in residential areas. Those of you who have children living with you and who have the privilege of living here in our 55+ community are racing through our streets. Please tell them to SLOW DOWN and to STOP AT STOP SIGNS. Every day there are near misses in our community. It's not worth your life or someone else's life. PLEASE SLOW DOWN!!

CURBING YOUR PET- All pets must be confined within the Owner's Lot/Living Unit except when being walked on a hand-held leash, not to exceed six feet (6') in length. Pet Owners are permitted to use the easement/patch of grass between the sidewalk and the curb. All Pet Owners must collect their pet's feces. Failure to pick up after your pet is a Holiday Heights fineable offense for each occurrence. There will also be an additional fine for each infraction under the Berkeley Township Ordinance (05-25-OAB-3). We expect all Pet Owners to be respectful of other Owners and in return, we expect Owners to show the same respect for Pet Owners.

Important Dates for the 2026 Election Cycle

August 3rd – Last day candidates not-in-good standing can rectify

August 13th - Mail-in ballots, summary of qualifications, and Instructions will be mailed to all Owners in Good Standing

August 18th - First Meet the Candidates Session – Tuesday, 7:00pm in the Auditorium

August 29th - Second Meet the Candidates Session – Saturday, 2:00pm

August 31st - Final date to request, in writing, to be a Candidate Representative

September 2nd - Last date for Nominees to correct and achieve Good Standing to be listed as a Candidate

September 8th - Election Day – Ballots returned & received in the P.O. Box by 5:00 pm

September 9th - Ballots will be publicly tallied in the Auditorium at 10:00 am and results Posted

September 10th - New Director Swearing-In Ceremony

Qualifications for Office

1. A candidate for the Board shall be an Owner in Good Standing as defined in N.J.S.A.45:22A-23r.
2. Being an Owner in Good Standing as defined in N.J.S.A. 45:22A-23r shall be the sole criterion for an Owner to be eligible to run as a nominee, be elected to the Board, and serve as a Director of the Board
3. Not more than one Owner of a Lot shall run for or serve on the Board simultaneously with another Owner of the same Lot.
4. A Director shall not serve, pro-tem or otherwise, as a chairperson or member of either standing or "ad hoc" committee, or as an officer of any club in the Holiday Heights Community and this shall not be subject to grandfathering.

Responsibilities of Office

1. To read, understand, abide by, and uphold the Certificate of Incorporation, Bylaws, Declaration, and the Rules, including the Directors Code of Conduct.
2. To understand and agree that a Director is elected as one of seven (7) equal Directors by the Owners of the Association and that each Director has an equal voice in the affairs of the Board and the conduct of the Association
3. To attend a voluntary pre-orientation meeting with the Election Committee Chairperson and an Officer of the current Board to provide a full understanding of a Director's roles and responsibilities.
4. To aid and assist in the ongoing work of the Board and the management of the Association and to accept a fair share of the tasks deemed necessary by the Board to accomplish same.
5. To accept Direct Responsibility associated with facilities, staff, and duties/tasks related to Board obligations.
6. To accept the role of Liaison Director to one or more Association committees and the work it entails.
7. To understand and agree that no member of the Board shall receive compensation from the Association, except for reimbursement of legitimate expenses incurred, with the prior approval of the Board, in the performance of duties and obligations as a member of the Board.
8. To understand and agree that a Director may not speak for or commit the Board to any action, purchase, or position without proper authority of the other members of the Board
9. To agree and accept that if a purchase is made or work is authorized by a Board member without approval or ratification by a quorum of the Board, the Board is under no obligation to pay and instead the Director who authorized to commit the Association would be personally responsible and the Association shall be defended, indemnified and held harmless by the unauthorized Director for all claims arising from and relating to such unauthorized purchase or work.
10. To understand and agree that a Director may take a public position on any subject but shall always identify the position as their own personal opinion and not that of the Board or the Association as a whole.
11. To agree and accept the responsibility of attending Board and Homeowners meetings as scheduled. Three (3) unexcused absences within a three-month period or three (3) consecutive unexcused absences may be grounds for suspension or dismissal from the Board.

Roll Call – all officers present
Carol introduced Senator Amato

Senator Amato reviewed several programs available to our community. He reviewed a few bills that are on the table in the state. Gift bags were distributed. Advised everyone to fill out the enclosed form with their email to receive updates on what's going on. Veterans book available services to them. Trust for property were reviewed. Energy prices were reviewed.

Carol B - reviewed needs for a recreation chairperson and hospitality team, who are needed approximately 7 x a year.

There is a need for a pool volunteer on the weekends. This is a paid position.

Veterans wall is complete and Carol acknowledged all involved.

Carol H. Reviewed Access card . Carol H reviewed the reader at the pool and how it looks different. She asked that the pool gate be closed and not slammed. Continued repairs have been made to the gate.

Question if the badges are water safe. Carol will review. Tuesday ID cards are taken 10am to 12pm, and 1 hour before board meetings.

Lorraine – announced the upcoming election and dates.

Tim – reviewed the financials. Explained why we have fluctuation in income.

Question on why the short-term CD, explained we get better rates and need money available to pay bills. Snow is the expense that hit us hardest. March and April Capital reserve payments were held to be comfortable with paying bills. Fourth quarter must be closely watched. One owner asked if we could build a reserve for large expense items like snow. Another asked if there would be a community vote if we changed the snow removal. If it was decided to remove snow removal it would have to be voted on by the entire community.

George – reviewed grass complaints are minimal this year. He reviewed the difference between Carol H and his robo calls. The event call will only list two months of events

Carol H asked for a new recreational leaders. She discussed how other communities do it.

Don – reviewed only 5 volunteers so far, we need more volunteers for the pool. We need weekend volunteers. Residents and Don discussed issues at hand.

Committees reviewed their events.

Owners discussed their dissatisfaction with the pool. The difference of the monitors vs attendants.

Meeting ended at 8:30pm.

GRASS CUTTING POLICY

Sprinkler heads are the Owner's responsibility

All Grass Cutting Issues must be reported to the HOA Office in writing, using the Lawn Complaint Form (forms are available at the HOA Office or on our website at holidayheights.org). Please do not call the Lawn Contractor or a Director. A complaint form must be filled out for all complaints. If no complaint form is filled out the complaint will be voided.

Damage to property such as siding, fences, borders and sprinklers will be addressed in a timely manner. Our contractor has staff to handle these repairs. Should you have damage, please take responsible measures to prevent further damage. All complaints will be inspected by a Director to determine the cause and action to be taken. Repairs made by homeowners prior to the Director's inspection and without authorization by the Board, will not be reimbursed. Please ensure the cutters have a clear path and your sprinkler heads are down on grass cutting days. Sprinkler heads damaged due to heads being raised during the cut cycle **will not** be repaired by the Lawn Contractor. If you have heads that do not retract, place red do-not cut flags around the head until you can have it repaired, also confirm all ground panels are secured.

Damage to lawns such as scalping and ruts will be considered on a **case-by-case** basis. Some will grow back without intervention. The majority of ruts are caused by the ground being over saturated due to recent rain and/or over watering by the sprinklers. The driver is most likely unaware of the saturated ground until it is too late. Ruts caused by Homeowners over watering their lawn will not be repaired by the Lawn Contractor. Please check your side and rear yards as needed to ensure the ground is not over saturated. If you find there are areas that are over saturated, please obtain red flags from the HOA Office and circle the saturated areas so the mowers know not to cut that area.

No Cut Signs are a violation and are subject to a fine if placed on your lawn.

"No Cut" flags are available in the HOA Office for those not wanting the Association to cut their grass. You will need to fill out the No Lawn Cut form and you will be given flags at the HOA Office. If you change your mind and decide you want your lawn cut, please remove the flags.

Under normal soil conditions, grass requires only ½ to 1 inch of water per week. Our soils are generally wetter due to the high-water table and type of soil; therefore, discuss this with your sprinkler contractor and ask them to adjust the frequency and run times on your sprinkler system for roughly ¾ inch per week. Also ask them to adjust your system as needed throughout the watering season. Remember the water requirements for the area between the homes may be less than the front and back, work with your neighbors to establish a watering schedule. Watering your lawn every day is not needed unless it is a new seeding.

Holiday Heights 2026 Pool Rules

(Our Pool Rules Supersede State Rules)

- Everyone must use personal access cards to enter the pool area including guests. No sign in is required.
- All guests must be accompanied by a Homeowner/Resident and remain with the guest while in the pool area.
- No “solo/alone” swimming. Two people must always be in or at the pool.
- Children may attend the pool between 10:00am to 12:30pm and leave the pool area by 1:00pm. Monday and Wednesday Evenings 5:00pm to 6:30pm and leave the pool area 7:00pm. Homeowner/Resident must be present and supervise children. No children under the age of 3 are allowed in the pool.
- **No children or adult diapers including “Swim diapers, Swimmates, Swimmers, pull ups” are allowed in the pool.**
- Smoking or eating inside the pool area is not allowed.
- No alcohol or recreational drugs are allowed in the pool, pool area, or pavilion. Only plastic bottles are allowed in the pool area.
- The pool and pool area must be cleared for inclement weather and emergency situations. After 30 minutes without any thunder or lightning, you may return to the pool area.
- No shoes, flip flops, towels, goggles, or floatation devices are to be left by the steps or ladders due to safety hazard.
- Chairs, lounges, and tables may **NOT** be reserved. Tables cannot be utilized by anyone or group for all day or evening. The tables are for snacking only. Please keep the tables clean for others during the day and evening.
- All equipment, chairs, lounges, tables, noodles, etc. must be returned to their original place.
- All personal items left at the pool will be discarded at the end of the season.
- No sitting or eating on the pool steps.
- No running, jumping or diving into the pool. No pushing, shoving, rude, loud or profane language will be tolerated. If you are disruptive or refuse to follow the pool rules, you will be requested to refrain from this behavior. Refusal to refrain from this behavior will result in a Director being contacted and you be removed from the pool area. Refusal to be removed may result in a Code of Conduct violation.
- All complaints must go to a Director for a resolution or implementation.
- **If you have an open sore, infection, or diarrhea, please STAY OUT OF THE POOL.**
- Sunscreen should be applied 30 minutes before entering the pool to avoid clogging the pool drains.
- **This is a Senior Community, and we would like to keep it peaceful. Respect others.**
- **The pool will open on Memorial Day weekend and close on September 7th weather permitting. Pool Hours are 8am to 8pm unless otherwise posted.**

Legislation Update S1526:

Sponsored by Senator Carmen Amata: On May 18, 2026 this proposed legislation was referred to the Budget and Finance Committee. S1526 increases fines on scammers stealing identity of a senior citizen.

Legislation Update: S4306:

Sponsored by Senator Carmen Amato. If passed, S4306 will make permanent the additional \$250 property tax benefit for certain senior citizen homeowners and tenants:

- Homeowners 65 years of age or older with a gross income not to exceed \$250,000 for the tax year that is used to determine such resident homestead owner's eligibility for the \$250 Anchor Property Tax Relief Program.
- Renters 65 years of age or older whose homestead is a residential rental property with gross income not in excess of \$150,000 for the tax year that is used to determine eligibility of the Anchor Property Tax Relief Program is eligible for an additional benefit in the amount of \$250.

Forgotten History

History and Hollowood

Excerpt from associate professor of medieval history University of Oxford, Hannah Skoda

Hollowood produces many “historically” based films, most are usually very entertaining. Most directors and writers do take some license stretching facts to make it more exciting. Braveheart was a 1995 epic which tells the story of the Scot rebel Sir William Wallace (1274 -1305), who fought against the wicked and exploitative King Edward of England. A very entertaining film with lots of action, a good story line, heartfelt romance and some comedy. It was very loose on facts, however.

In one scene it shows the Scots wearing kilts. Braveheart was based on events between 1275 and 1300. Kilts were not introduced by Scots until the late 16th century. William Wallace was cast as poor peas-

ant stock; he was actually a minor nobleman. Edward I reclaimed the right to interrupt Scottish weddings so that English aristocrats could ravish the bride; this is fabricated. The battle of Stirling Bridge was actually fought in another location, nowhere near a bridge. Isabella of France is shown falling in love with Wallace just before his execution in 1305. Actually, she was nine years old at that time and living in France. Blue face paint may have been used 1,000 years earlier, but certainly not in the early 14th century.

So, we should not trust Hollowood for historical facts but just for great entertainment. Braveheart is a great watch, and brilliantly evocative but not a very good history lesson.

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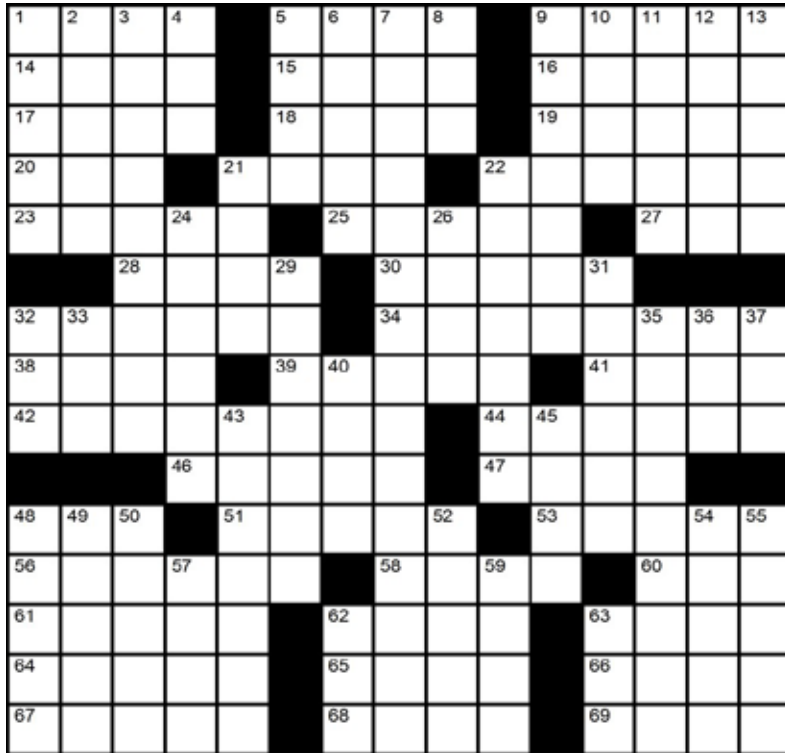
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Crossword

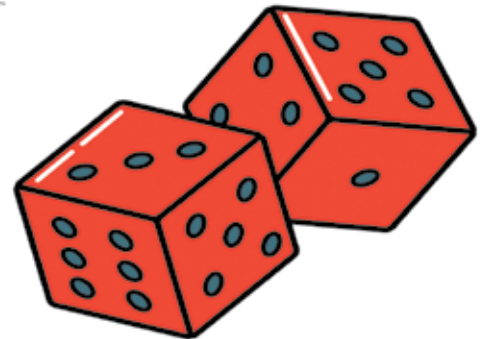
